

INSTRUCTIONS FOR NEW FACULTY-LED PROGRAM PROPOSAL

Center for Global Engagement

The Center for Global Engagement invites Baylor University faculty members to propose new faculty-led study abroad programs. *The Center for Global Engagement will approve a maximum of three new programs*. A competitive program proposal will demonstrate a clear need for Baylor, student demand, a well-developed program vision, substantial consideration of health and safety risks, and financial feasibility. Approved programs will be eligible to conduct a site visit in the summer or fall following approval.

Faculty members are eligible to propose and lead a faculty-led study abroad program if they have served in a full-time teaching capacity at Baylor University for at least three years and have the support of their department chair. It is preferred that faculty members have experience in the proposed location(s) and with leading study abroad or international travel programs with students. Ideal program proposals will be anchored in one location and intentionally provide opportunities to engage deeply with the host culture through both relationship-building and cultural experiences. It is strongly preferred that faculty members partner with recommended vendors for travel and program logistics. Contact Study Abroad for recommendations specific to your program vision.

Logistically, faculty-led programs are offered in either Summer 1 or Summer 2 for roughly five to six weeks in length. There must be a strong rationale for offering a program outside the Office of the Registrar's calendar dates for summer terms. Students are expected to take six hours of credit.
